



KAHALU'U COMMUNITY MASTER PLAN

The purpose of the Kahalu'u Community Master Plan is to develop a plan for Kahalu'u that will provide general design guidance and prioritize future physical improvement projects in support of the community's efforts to realize their vision for Kahalu'u. Through a community-based planning process facilitated by the City and County of Honolulu and its project consultant (Helber Hastert & Fee, Planners), the Plan will consider physical, social, urban design and transportation issues.

The process to create the Master Plan will involve a series of workshops to be held within the community, giving residents the opportunity to share their ideas, review and comment on plan alternatives, and be an active participant in the development of their community's plan. In addition, meetings will be held with a 17-member Advisory Working Group (AWG) comprised of representatives from Kahalu'u and presentations will be conducted for the Kahalu'u Neighborhood Board.
