The Mākaha Special Area Plan was prepared pursuant to the recommendations of the Wai‘anae Sustainable Communities Plan (SCP) adopted in July, 2000. The SCP recognized that a large portion of Mākaha Valley was designated State Land Use Urban, contained large undeveloped parcels, and is an important resource area for water, rare and endangered plants and animals, and cultural sites. The objective of this Plan is to balance preservation of the Valley’s rural environment and character with the existing urban zoning.
