

FLOOD HAZARD ZONE LEGEND

A	No Base Flood Elevation (BFE) determined.
AE	Base Flood Elevation determined.
AE-FLOODWAY	<p>The water course or portion of the floodplain which must be reserved in order to carry or discharge the regulatory flood without cumulatively increasing the flood elevation of the floodplain more than a foot at any point.</p> <p>Temporary or permanent structures, fill storage or material or equipment or other improvements which affect the capacity of the floodway or increase the regulatory flood elevations shall be allowed.</p>
AH	Flood depth of 1 to 3 feet (usually areas of ponding); base flood elevations determined.
AO	Flood depth of 1 to 3 feet (usually sheet flow on sloping terrain); average depths determined. For areas with alluvial fan flooding, velocity also determined.
A99	To be protected from 100-year flood by Federal flood protection system under construction; no base flood elevations determined.
V	Coastal flood with velocity hazard (wave action); no base flood elevation determined.
VE	Coastal flood with velocity hazard (wave action); base flood elevation determined.
XS	Areas of 500-year flood; areas of 100-year flood with average depths of less than 1 foot with drainage areas less than 1 square mile; and areas protected by levees from 100-year flood.
X	Areas determined to be outside 500-year floodplain.
D	Areas which flood hazards are undetermined.
ERM or RM	Elevation Reference Mark.
