

JOB OPPORTUNITIES

PLANNER (FORECASTING)

The position is in the Planning Research Branch of the Department of Planning and Permitting, the agency responsible for long-range and community planning efforts for the City and County. The Branch is engaged in land use and demographic analysis and modeling, forecasting, Census analysis, development monitoring, statistical and geographic analysis, and research support of regional planning. This position will participate in the following activities:

- Review, evaluate and refine land use model mechanism and design.
- Monitor changes in land use, employment and housing, in relation to changes in development regulations and statistical area boundaries.
- Represent department in State Data Center functions and in Census programs.
- Work with project team to gather and organize input data needed by models to generate land use forecasts in response to changes in development policies, infrastructure developments and market conditions.

Experience with urban models in general and the UrbanSim model in particular is preferred. Position will be filled at the [Planner IV](#) level (refer to Department of Human Resources website, <http://www4.honolulu.gov/hrjobclass/index3.htm>).

ARCHITECT/URBAN PLANNER

The position is under the Community Planning Branch. The registered architect must be able to develop and evaluate community plans and guide development proposals in which land use planning, circulation, site planning, an urban design are major considerations. Experience in transit-oriented development planning is desirable, as is experience with preparing policies on urban design and land use planning.
